What to Know Before You Go

Instructions for Visitors to the Reveille Wild Horse Gather

<u>When to meet</u>: Call our <u>Wild Horse Gather Info Line at</u> (775) 861-6700 for the next day's departure time and directions to the meeting location, and the previous days gather results. *Note: gather operations are dependent on weather and could change with little or no notice.*

We will caravan out to the gather site each day. We may not know the exact location of these sites until the day before (all depends on where the horses are), so be flexible.

Transportation: All visitors must have their own transportation – we cannot take people in government vehicles. The gather site and temporary holding corrals will move around to several locations and the roads can get very rough in and around the area. Vehicles MUST HAVE 4-wheel drive with high clearance. Visitors must have spare ties (we suggest multiple spare tires!). Gas and full services are available in Tonopah, Nevada. *Cell phones are also a good idea if you get stranded, though coverage cannot be quaranteed.*

Amenities: There are motels in Tonopah if you are coming here from outside the area.

Weather conditions: This is Nevada in January so plan for cold days! Dress accordingly and bring plenty of water.

What to bring:

- Closed-toed sturdy shoes
- Bland-colored clothing (no wild colors, please)
- Sunscreen
- Food and water
- Binoculars
- Camera with zoom lens
- Small beach chair if you don't like to sit on rocks

^{*}There will not be a prota-potty at the trap site so plan accordingly.
