



Comprehensive Animal Welfare Program (CAWP)

- Comprehensive Applies to all management activities of the WHB Program.
- Animal Welfare Safeguarding the well-being of the wild horses and burros by ensuring humane treatment, adequate care, and animal handling with care and compassion.
- Program A formal program not just a philosophy or general code of conduct.



BLM's History of Animal Welfare

- 1959 through 1970's and 80's regulations, policies and procedures put in place to protect animal welfare.
- 1999 BLM started engaging animal welfare experts to advise the WHB Program.
- 2010 BLM began formalizing a comprehensive animal welfare program.
- 2013 BLM issues instruction memorandum (IM) to apply the CAWP to wild horse and burro gathers.
- 2021 BLM hires permanent CAWP Coordinator and issues permanent CAWP policy.



CAWP Instruction Memorandum

Purpose

- Re-affirms and demonstrates the agency's commitment to humane treatment of wild horses and burros.
- Standardizes BLM's longstanding practices.
- Direction, guidance, training, and requirements for BLM employees, contractors, and partners.


