


The benefit of this project is that it will ensure that the dams provide another 70 years of service controlling stormwater and sustaining watershed health.

Description: The five Starvation Draw dams no longer support the resource management program. This project will construct grade control structures in the dam embankments to control future stormwater and eliminate the deferred maintenance backlog.
