




Wyoming BLM Dam Safety Repairs and Maintenance Projects

District or **Unit Name: High Desert** and High Plains Districts

Recreational Values: Boating, fishing, hiking, hunting, picnicking, wildlife viewing













Description: This project repairs three high hazard dams (Little Sage Creek, Little Robber, and Snyder Creek) and associated features. The repair of dam spillways, gates, and outlet structures will improve the safe operation of the dams. Additional embankment maintenance and installation of protective riprap will stabilize the dams and prevent seepage and erosion.
