### **Comprehensive Animal Welfare Program** What is the C-A-W-P? Purpose

- Comprehensive Applies to all management activities of the WHB Program.
- Animal Welfare Safeguarding the well-being of the wild horses and burros by ensuring humane treatment, adequate care, and animal handling with care and compassion.
- **Program** A formal program not just a philosophy or general code of conduct.

- Re-affirms and demonstrates the agency's commitment to humane treatment of wild horses and burros
- Standardizes BLM's longstanding practices
- Direction, guidance, training, and requirements for BLM employees, contractors, and partners




