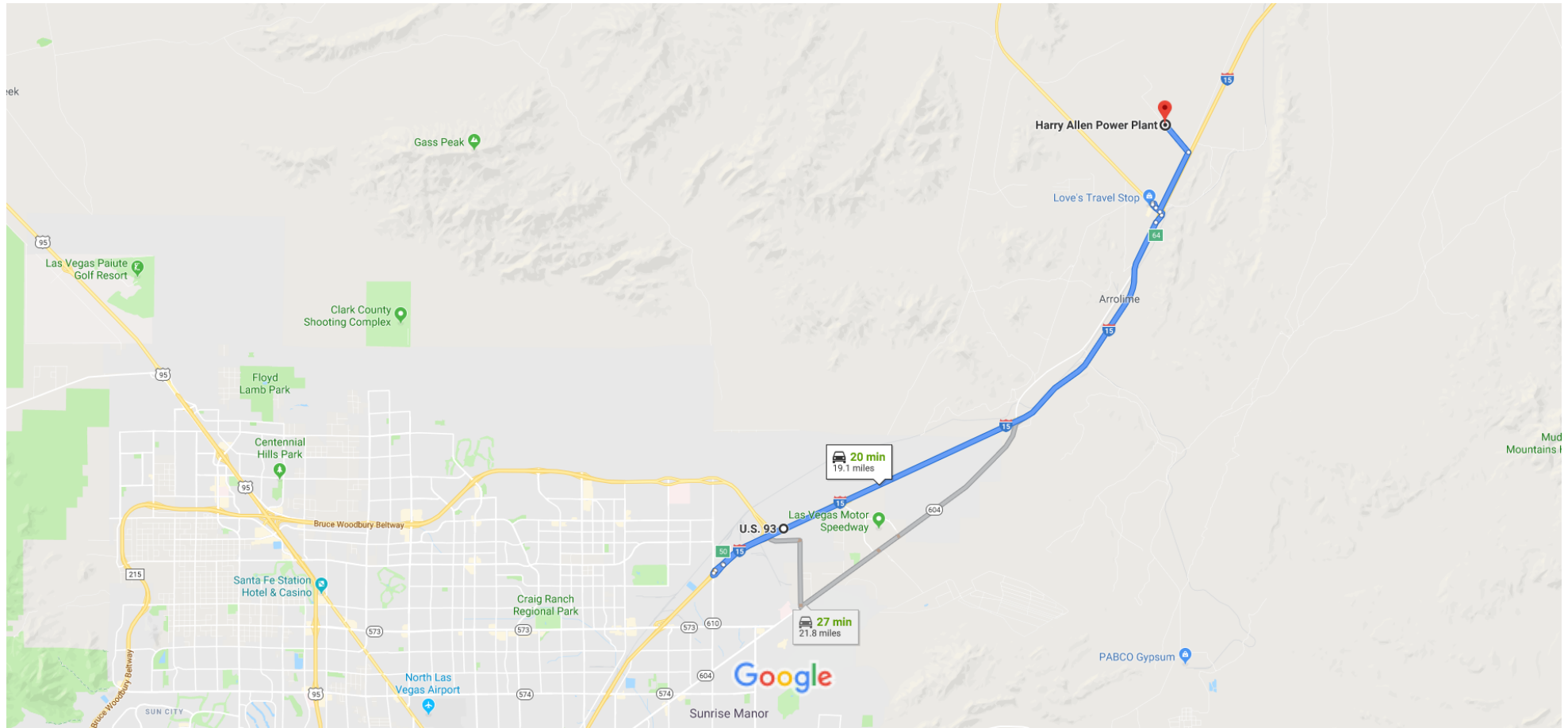

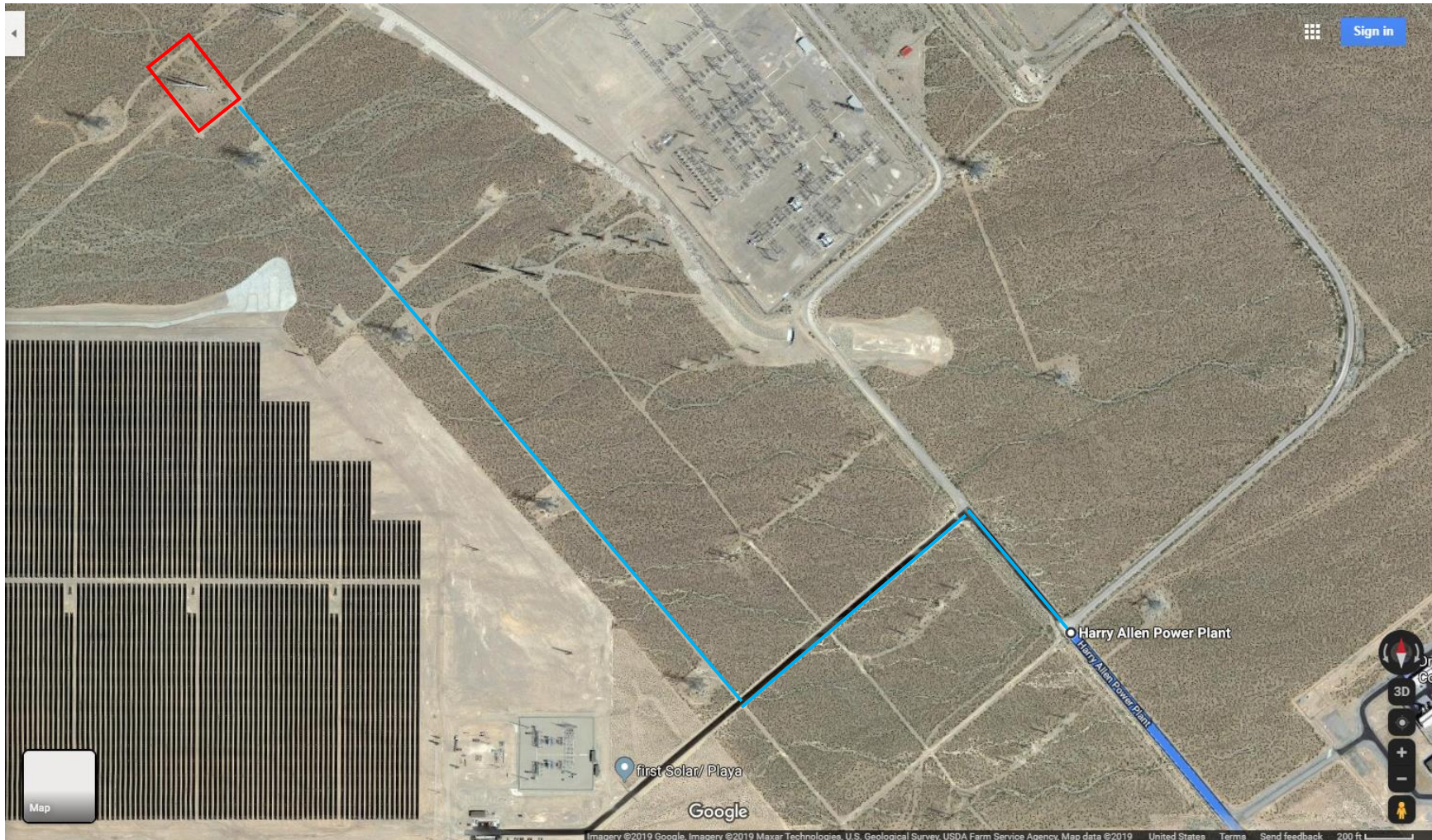

Directions to Cacti/Yucca Sale (Cont.)



- Continue onto paved road for ~550 ft and then turn left to stay on paved road.
- Stay on this paved road for ~1/2 mile
- Turn right onto powerline road and continue down powerline road to parking area

What to Bring and Permit Conditions



What to Bring:

- CASH OR CHECK ONLY – NO CREDIT CARDS
- You must bring your own materials to pick up and move the plant(s). These supplies will vary depending on the size and number of plants you purchased. At a minimum, you will need:
 - **Gloves** - heavy leather or thick gardening gloves - one pair for every person who will be helping - these need to be resistant to cactus spines or sharp yucca leaves. It can help to have an old towel or mat to use to help move cacti.
 - **Shovel** - most of the plants in the nursery are very shallowly rooted, but you will still need to dig them up to move the roots all together
 - **Plant Transport Method** - bucket, tarps, large plastic garbage bags, old towels, or thick fabric to wrap the plant and/or the plant roots in - this will again depend on the size and type of plant you are picking up. It would also be useful, if you have space in your vehicle, to have a cart or wheelbarrow with you! Some plants are very heavy and you can't drive on site. Towels and tarps will protect your vehicle from dirt and spines from the plants; a large bucket will be sufficient to hold most small, and some medium cacti; yucca will need a towel or tarp to wrap the roots in (they are probably too big for any buckets you have).
- Large plants (barrel cacti and Mojave yucca) will require at least 2 people, and possibly 3 people, to successfully move - some plants are heavy, awkward, and/or delicate - you will also need a larger vehicle to pick up Mojave yucca – they are big!
- No driving will be permitted on site – you will need to carry your plants to your vehicle. So a wheelbarrow or cart would be helpful to help you transport your plant(s) from their locations to your vehicle.

Permit Conditions:

- Permits only open to people who have a Nevada license or identification.
- Plants are available on a first-come, first-serve basis (you cannot call and "reserve" a plant)
- These plants are NOT for resale!!! You are not permitted to resell these plants. They are for personal use only, not commercial use.
- There is a limit of 15 total cacti and yucca and 15 total other plants (perennial shrubs or grasses) per household for this sale.

More information:

- Please remember – harvesting cacti and yucca (including Joshua trees) from the wild is illegal! These plants are being made available to the public because they would otherwise have been destroyed.
- There is no guarantee your plant will survive. These plants are being made available to the public for personal use at a very discounted price and you will not get a refund or a replacement plant if your plant doesn't survive
- Keep in mind that these are desert plants - too much water will definitely kill them - they are prone to root rot if they are watered too often or they are planted in areas that do not drain well. When in doubt, Google how to care for these plants during and after transplant.
