OIG High Risk Boundary General Guidance

Guidance

- A. Nominations submitted under this Instruction Memorandum (IM) will be requested by parties external to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) State Office Cadastral Survey and Geographic Coordinate Data Base programs.
- B. Requests may include both lands managed by the BLM and by Federal land management agencies external to the BLM. External customers include other Federal, including Indian, land management agencies.
- C. All nominations will be coordinated by the State Office Chief Cadastral Surveyor responsible for the jurisdictional area affected.
- D. The Nomination Questionnaire must be completed in its entirety for each request. The space provided for each question may be expanded as needed to allow for a complete description.
- E. Additional information may be requested by the Washington Office (WO) after receipt of nominations.
- F. Each nomination must be accompanied by a Condition of Survey map conforming to examples provided to each State Office Chief Cadastral Surveyor. Uniformity will facilitate efficient panel review.
- G. All funded projects must be field completed no later than 09/30/11.
- H. All funding, including contributions from other sources, must be coded to special interest project code HRRB.
- I. The Project Completion Questionnaire must be provided to the WO within 10 days of project completion.

Purpose for Providing Services

- A. Demonstrate results to the Office of Inspector General (OIG) in identifying and recovering revenues lost as a result of uncertain boundary location.
- B. Demonstrate results to OIG in protecting resources that have potential to be lost as a result of uncertain boundary location.
- C. Demonstrate results to OIG in identifying future rents resulting from unauthorized utilities on federally managed lands.
- D. Identify lands that have potential to generate revenue for the repair of damaged lands
