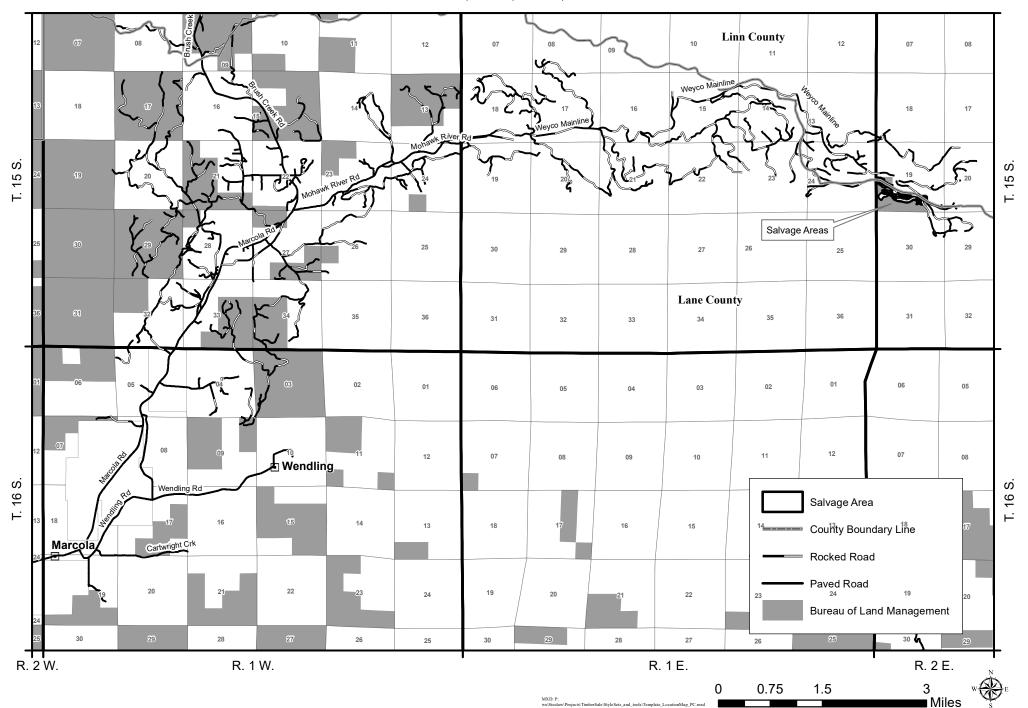
Minor League Purchaser Informational Meeting September 8, 2021, 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm

Timber Sale Location Map Minor League Salvage

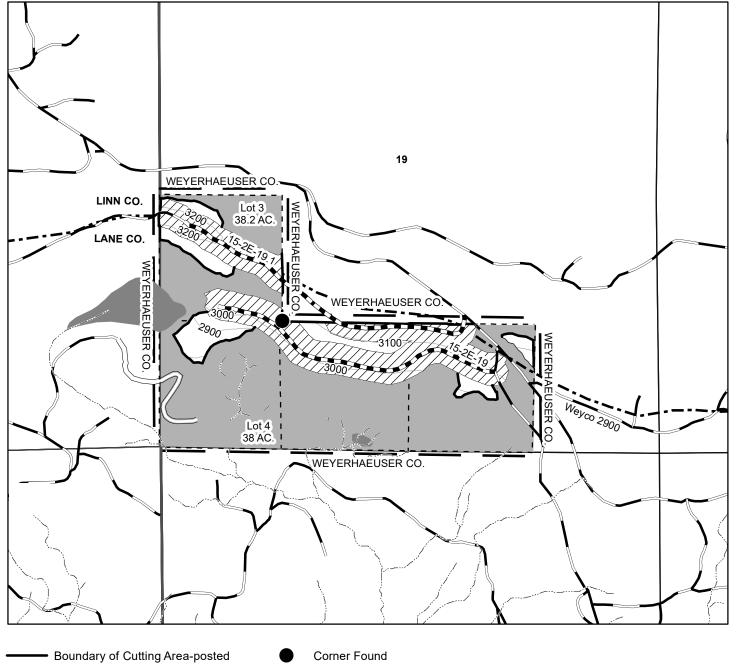
