## Upcoming Federal Interagency Broadband Permitting Summit Hosted by BLM and NTIA July 23-24 in Phoenix, AZ

The National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will hold a multi-agency summit to introduce State government broadband leaders, industry partners, broadband stakeholders, and other attendees to the permitting and environmental review requirements of various federal land and resource management agencies. Participating agencies will include BLM, the US Forest Service, the Federal Highway Administration, the Bureau of Reclamation, and the Bureau of Indian Affairs. Representatives from the US Army Corps of Engineers, the US Fish and Wildlife Service, and the National Park Service are also invited.

National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements specific to NTIA's Broadband Equity Access and Deployment (BEAD) program and other Internet for All grants will be the focus of the Summit's second day.

The event will be held at the <u>BLM National Training Center</u> in Phoenix, Arizona on Tuesday, July 23 and Wednesday, July 24. Event and logistical details and registration information will be available July 1st.
