SITUATION

Current Situation: A local Color Country Interagency Incident Management Type-3 Team is responding to a 1,200-acre wildfire that was initially discovered today at 1:02 PM. The fire is burning on Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument, south of Bryce Canyon approximately 21 miles northeast of Kanab, Utah. The fire is currently moving south of Skutumpah Road.
