SITUATION

Current Situation: Today fence repair started on the interior of the fire, while dozer line repair is planned to begin in the next couple of days. Crews continued to strengthen line along the flanks of the fire and below the rim. The fire did see minimal growth on the southwest flank, which produced minimal smoke. Crews were able to get around it in a timely manner and continue securing the line in that area.

Evacuations: None

Road Closures: Area and road closures are in effect. On Skutumpah Road between Johnson Canyon Road and Lick Wash the road is **open to resident traffic only**. Nephi Pasture and Crocodile parking lots, as well as Nephi Pasture Road are closed to the public as these areas will be used for fire operations only. We strongly discourage ALL recreational activities in the Nephi Pasture Region and along Skutumpah Road.
