SITUATION Current Situation: Interagency fire resources are working to take advantage of today's northeast winds which are currently pushing the fire south of Skutumpah Road. Today's operational priority is to secure the north flank of the fire, helping protect the Deer Springs Community and varying structures			
in the area once prevailing winds shift back, pushing the fire back to the north.			
Evacuations: <u>None</u> .
