SITUATION

Current Situation: Today's operations included continued work to secure the fire line on both flanks of the fire. Crews continued fire line construction and worked to contain any smaller fires that migrated off the rim. As the fire lines continue to strengthen, operations will combine two divisions on the east flank and continue to work on strengthening fire lines where the fire still remains active.

Evacuations: None.

Road Closures: Area and road closures are in effect. On Skutumpah Road between Johnson Canyon Road and Lick Wash the road is open to resident traffic only. Nephi Pasture and Crocodile parking lots, as well as Nephi Pasture Road are closed to the public as these areas will be used for fire operations only. We strongly discourage ALL recreational activities in the Nephi Pasture Region and along Skutumpah Road.
