Notice of Temporary Closure for Wildfire Suppression Efforts on BLM-managed Public Lands in Owyhee County, ID

AGENCY: Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Interior.

ACTION: Notice of Temporary Closure for Wildfire Suppression Efforts

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the BLM-managed Jump Creek Recreation Site, administered by the BLM Owyhee Field Office, will be temporarily closed to all entry by members of the public. Jump Creek Recreation Site is located seven miles southwest of Marsing, in southwestern Idaho. This order does not include private land.

DATES: This partial closure will be effective immediately and remain in effect until the threat of wildland fire has subsided.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Jump Fire is believed to have been sparked by lightning on Monday, August 5, approximately 15 miles south and southwest of Marsing. At the time of this closure notice, the fire has burned roughly 12,000 acres of grass and brush with 0% containment.

EXEMPTION: The following persons are exempt from this order: Federal, state, and local officers and employees in the performance of their official duties; members of organized rescue or fire-fighting forces in the performance of their official duties; and persons with written authorization from the BLM.

PENALTY: Individuals who violate this order may be fined not more than \$1,000 and/or imprisoned for no more than 12 months (Title 18 USC 1856, Title 43 USC 1701, Title 43 9212.4 and/or appropriate Idaho laws).
