Amount Expended: \$1,500.00

The BLM partnered with the Pacific Northwest Four Wheel Drive Association to host a poster contest promoting responsible public land use, Leave No Trace, and Tread Lightly principles. For the past 30 years, this program has visited the 5th grade classrooms for each Lake County, Oregon school to give a presentation and the opportunity to enter the hand-drawn poster contest. Winners have their posters placed in kiosks around the field office to encourage responsible recreation for all users.

Amount Expended: \$25,000.00

Fifty new signs were installed in the Lakeview Field Office, marking recreation sites, Wilderness Study Areas, and campgrounds, providing location names, directions, information, and regulations. The old, unreadable, or missing signs were updated to the new BLM black and white with color logos and state office images. More signs will be ordered and installed in future projects.
