Beaver Bench Connector Trail

Amount Expended: \$32,000.00

The Cedar City Field Office, in partnership with American Conservation Experience crews, constructed a 1-mile non-motorized trail in Beaver, UT. Construction consisted of a mix of machine and hand-build techniques. This new trail connects the recently completed National Interscholastic Cycling Association racecourse to the Beaver Bench Trail System. This work has expanded the trail system to 17 miles and has created more “frontcountry” recreation opportunities for the community.

Hanging Rock Campground Restroom



New Restroom Installed at Hanging Rock Campground

Amount Expended: \$28,000

The Hanging Rock Campground was constructed near Minersville, UT at the location previously known as Hanging Rock Recreation Area. Six campsites were implemented alongside the Beaver River. In 2023, the Cedar City Field Office installed a single vault restroom in the campground.
