Tips

- Check the GLORAS Help Center regularly for updated how-to guides and reference materials.
- Wildcard (*)
 - Ex: Gar* finds Garcia, Garza, Garner, Garces.
 - Use * when unsure of multiple characters.
 - Avoid starting searches with an asterisk unless necessary—this can return very large result sets.

Search Methods

Map Search best for general research on your project area (e.g., MTPs, HIs, Surveys).

- Search by:
 - Zoom to your area of focus
 - Address (city, county)
 - Legal Land Description: State, Meridian Code, Township, Range

Use the Identify  tool to select features on the map and view details.

Basic Search best used when you know a document number or want to use wildcards (*).

- Use when a document number is known or for wildcard searches.
- Examples:
 - Serialized Numbers: 23807, 21603, 43419
 - Patents: 602182, 828447
 - PLO: 6490, 342
 - EO: 5504
- Apply side-panel filters: Location, Document Type, etc.

Advanced Search filter by land description and document types to refine results.

- Apply filters to narrow results; you can start broader and refine with filters.
- Select applicable types.
