I will be sending several emails from Brian Bremner, Garfield County Engineer and Kane County Commissioner Dirk Clayson. Kelly Stowell is our film permit guy for Kane County and he tells me he won't even apply for a film permit in the monument because it takes months and months to even consider filming on the monument.

There is a great deal of vegetative manipulation going on in Kane and Garfield Counties, but nothing happening on GSENM lands. I spoke to Todd Gaziano last week. He is a lead attorney for Pacific States Legal Foundation. He and Law Professor John Yoo from Berkeley wrote the review of the Antiquities Act and strongly concluded that President Trump can significantly downsize, or eliminate a monument and no court will stop him.
